Applicant must be available to support five events in person in the Greater Philadelphia area during this time (see below for details).

### Internship Details:

\$20/hour; 30 hours total; 50/50 remote vs. onsite (onsite hours include travel time)

You will enhance your social media and graphic design skills and have the chance to apply your artistic vision to Usiloquy's social media presence. You will gain valuable experience in the nonprofit world—specifically with mission-driven communications strategy. You'll also represent and uphold our local arts organization by staffing our lively, high-stakes performance events and making connections in Philadelphia's vibrant art & culture scene.
